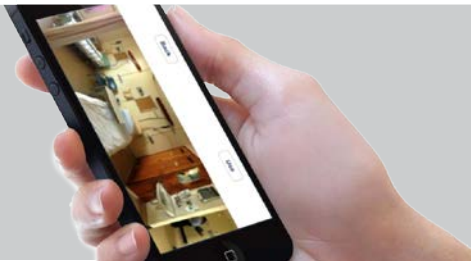

MODULES

Day 1

Touch Point Identification



Identifying TouchPoints will allow you to make better decisions on how and when surfaces should be cleaned within your facility. This module covers identifying, capturing, creating training sheets, and using TouchPoint markers and UV lights to increase the awareness of what should be cleaned and what surfaces were missed.

Task Analysis



Understanding what tasks, times and frequencies are currently being performed in your facility will help you to make better decisions in the future. This module will teach how to collect the data manually, enter it into a spreadsheet and sort and produce reports, identifying where your time and money is currently being spent.

Creating a Best Practice System



With the knowledge of what tasks are required to keep your facility clean you will work in teams to create the Easiest, Safest, Fastest, Cleanest system possible. This will be done with an eye on productivity, cross contamination, WH&S and levels of cleanliness all at the same time.

Day 2

Practice makes Perfect



This hands on module will prove that your tasks and times are achievable and can be performed without fatigue to the operator. You will identify what mistakes to avoid and what steps to practice to achieve your desired results.

Supervising



Implementing a C.H.I.P. system takes a lot of time and effort and requires the help of a cleaning supervisor to identify variances to the cleaning plan, and to train and re-train staff.
